History

Feline Outreach was founded by three cat lovers, who met through an online support group for caregivers of diabetic cats.

The founders wanted to form an organization dedicated to providing caregivers the educational and financial assistance necessary to care for their cats.

In 2006, Feline Outreach was formed and registered.

Mission

Our goal is to keep cats in homes.

Often caregivers find themselves faced with a seemingly overwhelming situation, but a helping hand can enable them to keep and care for their valued feline family member. Sometimes, all the caregiver needs is education on how to care for their cat. Other times, some financial assistance may be needed for a large veterinary bills.

Feline Outreach promotes routine and medical care of cats. Specifically, the organization may:

- Educate and support the public in the proper care of their cats
- Support research and study into nutrition, medical treatment, and other subjects pertaining to cats
- Enable shelters and the public to adopt, keep, and/or care for cats, particularly those with special needs - this support may be financial, educational, or in other forms
- Provide sanctuary, foster care, or transportation for cats with special medical needs or for whom adoption seems unlikely

Accomplishments

Since its inception, Feline Outreach has assisted several families with veterinary bills for emergency visits, surgeries, and other treatments. Often these individuals are on worker's compensation, disability, or unemployment and don't know where to turn for help with a large bill.

Sometimes, education can help them eliminate unnecessary bills or find less costly options.

We've also been pleased to present our "Paws for Education" awards to individuals or organizations we feel do an outstanding job at educating the public on caring for cats.
